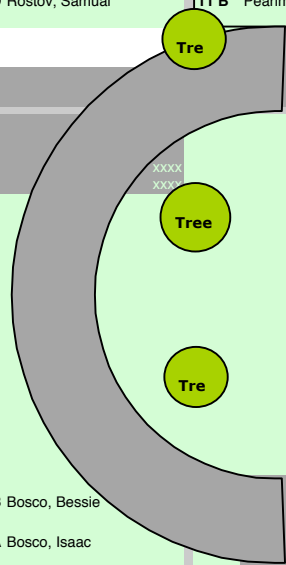

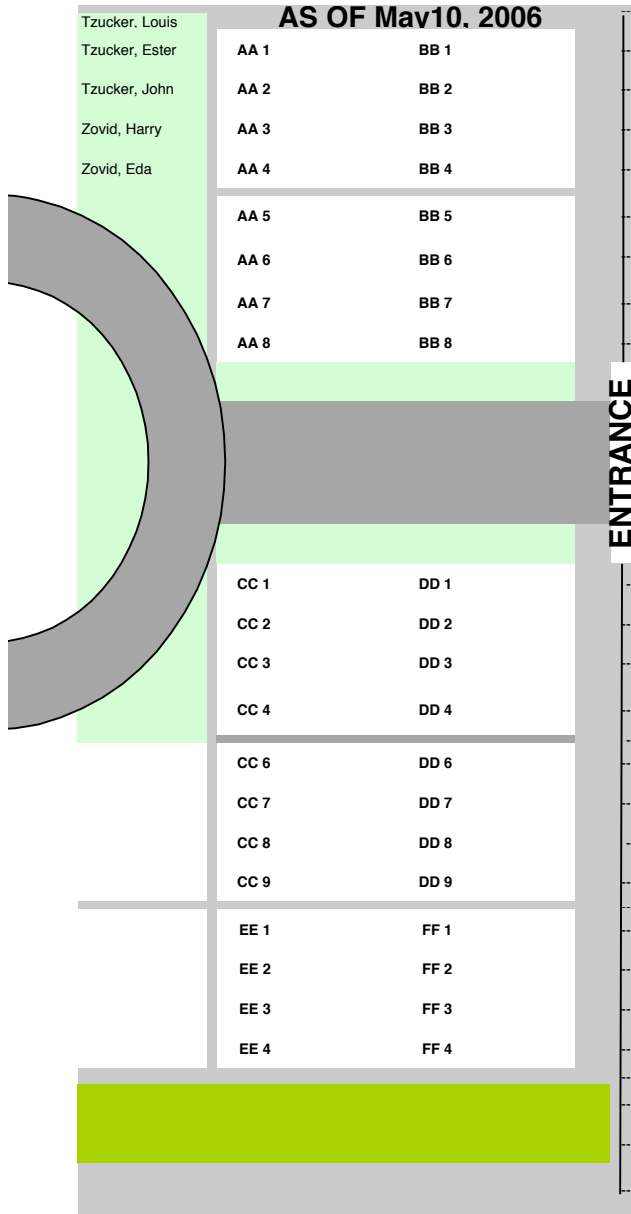

**NOTE:**

This map is neither to scale nor precise. Some plots are theoretical. It is a starting reference point and serves as a relational tool for the shul cemetery to identify burial sites, pre-purchased sites, and sites available for purchase.

The existence of the service road to the end of the cemetery was not identified in previous maps. There is flexibility for the congregation to determine actual road positioning and plot locations. I have attempted to assign identification numbers for all possible sites and indicate plots invalidated by the road. Trees have voided some plots or possibly enveloped graves. Only several existing trees are identified.

The cemetery is dynamic and the congregation has been innovative and resourceful in placing graves to circumvent natural and artificial boundaries problems to facilitate its needs. There is flexibility for the congregation to determine actual road positioning and plot locations. I have attempted to assign identification numbers for all possible sites and indicate plots invalidated by the road.
